## **Treasures of Paphos**

We begin our day with a stop at a pottery workshop in Yeroskipou village, where we will see how the potters continue the ancient traditional craft and if you are lucky, you might even try your hand at the wheel.

Our next stop is at the village square where we will see the unique 5-domed church of St Paraskevi, built in the 9th century reputedly on the site where the ancient temple of Aphrodite previously stood.

We will also have a chance to see how the 'loukoumia' (Cyprus delights) are made and wander around the square with its local produce shops.

From there we will go to a small village, Letymbou, where we will visit Sophia's traditional house where you can experience rooms with the original furniture and décor as well as traditional costumes.


You will learn how to bake village bread in the clay oven and makes other local delicacies such as the traditional halloumi cheese. Afterwards we will have a brunch —a special "Cypriot breakfast", prepared by Sophia (included in the price).

Next, we will visit the Saint Neophytos monastery and the "Enkleistra", an enclosure which was carved out of the mountain in the 12th century by the hermit Neophytos and contains some of the finest Byzantine frescoes. The main church of the monastery was built around 200 years after the death of St Neophytos and is dedicated to the Virgin Mary.

# **Aphrodite's Trail**

Discover Aphrodites footsteps on an unforgettable journey around the Western side of the island. Begin in Petra tou Romiou, also known as Aphrodite's Rock, the mythical birthplace of the goddess Aphrodite, and take in the stunning views of the Cypriot coastline.

We then head of to Koulia village to visit the Sanctuary of Aphrodite the most famous of the Ancient Greek Goddess' sanctuaries, and its ancient remains date back to the 12th century BC, whilst it remained a place of worship until the 3rd - 4th centuries AD.

Then its of to The natural grotto of the Baths of Aphrodite, and its botanical garden, can be found past the fishing harbour of Latsi, and towards the tip of the Akamas Peninsula.

Shaded by an old fig tree, amidst lush greenery, legend tells that the Ancient Greek Goddess Aphrodite used to bathe in the waters. According to Greek mythology, Aphrodite met her lover Adonis at this beautiful spot when he stopped for a drink whilst hunting, and fell in love with her the moment when he drank the water.

After lunch at the harbour of latchi we head of to Kathikas village to sample some wine before heading back to the hotel

# **Paphos Wine Rout**

Embark on a wine excursion of Cyprus' Paphos region on a guided tour by minivan. Visit four small, privately owned wineries that specialize in the production of original varietal and blended wines. Taste local wines and learn about the wine tradition of the region.

See first-hand how the limited production of local wines makes these unique products even more precious. At each winery you visit, see how the wine is made before savoring a tasting. Firstly, go to Katikas Village to walk in the vineyards and visit the Vassilikon Winery one of the oldest in the area. It covers around 4,000-square-meters, including the production area, cellars, bar, and wine museum. Learn about the 350,000 bottles of wine that are bottled here each year. Next, head to the village of Lemony, where the Tsangaridis family winery is lost amongst vineyards and old rustic buildings. This is a new generation winery where old traditions are combined with new technologies.

Then, head to Strumbi Village to visit the Kamanterena Winery. Established in 1974, it is a wine cooperative that brings together some 10,000 families from 144 vineyards. Over the years, the winery has continually participated in wine fairs and has earned several prestigious awards. Finally, visit the Vuni Panaya Winery, tucking into a fresh lunch at your leisure after your tasting. This winery has been in existence since 1987 and has a good range of wines, its own museum, and a restaurant. Buy a few bottles to savor once you're back home and thinking of the glorious days you spent on this small but cozy Mediterranean island.
